

# VoteWA Executive Steering Committee

Effective December 9, 2020

The Executive Steering Committee (the Committee) is the highest decision-making body and as such is responsible for advising on strategic and administrative issues.

The Committee (13 total members) consists of representatives from County Election Offices and the Secretary of State’s Office. The Washington State Association of County Auditors elects eight county auditors as representatives to the Committee. The Secretary of State’s Office appoints two county auditors from County Election Offices and three representatives from the Secretary of State’s Office.
